Ready to share your gifts with our global faith community?!

Assembly is around the corner and we would love for you to share your gifts, talents, skills, ideas, and anything else that you can offer for Assembly. There is a lot of work to do at Assembly: we would love to have you as a volunteer while you participate in Assembly Indonesia 2022!

The three main areas for volunteers right now:

- interpreters/ translators and on-site volunteers that are able to work 4-6 hours each day,
- and volunteers that are able to arrive about a month before Assembly to help with the preparation.

We are looking for skilled volunteers who can share with us their gift of translation and interpretation. We are looking for interpreters who fluently speak two of the following MWC assembly 2022 languages: **Spanish, French, English** and **Indonesian**.

During Assembly, we would love to have volunteers who could spare **4-6 hours a day**, working on a variety of tasks as needed throughout Assembly.

If you are interested in attending Assembly and volunteering while there, you can register as a volunteer and fill out the volunteer registration form to get a special discount on your registration fee.

Also, if you live in **Central Java** and are willing to volunteer full time for Assembly, you can apply for a waiver of your registration fee.

For the month before Assembly starts, we are looking for a few international and local volunteers who can spend one month in Indonesia to serve. This is a great opportunity for young people to work in an international team, learn about MWC, the Indonesian church, and support the Assembly with your skills and gifts. MWC will cover the registration fee, food and lodging. You will be asked to cover your own travel, visa, insurance and possible quarantine expenses.

## Online Volunteers

If you are unable to pack and join us in person, but you still want to share your gifts, we have also a great opportunity for volunteering from home. We have positions for **translators/interpreters, content writers, tech support, online facilitators**, and other roles that you can fill from your home.
