

Feedback on: Mennonite World Conference
World Fellowship Sunday, January 27, 2013
From: Bogota, Colombia

Magali Moreno, a Mennonite World Conference staff person in the Bogota, Colombia office sent an email on January 29: "We had a great time last Sunday when MWC members of the three conferences in Colombia* joined together to celebrate World Fellowship Sunday. The service started at 10:00 am. Five to ten minutes before, the church was packed... There were about 300 people including children. César García, MWC general secretary, preached. Pastors, leaders and members from different churches in Bogota alternated in leading the service, singing with the congregation and praying. There was also a testimony from Justapaz. Children were divided by ages for Sunday school. We distributed 200 copies of the Pennsylvania 2015 News No.1 and many bookmarks. At the end people shared food for the service was over at midday. It was the first time that the Anabaptist congregations in Bogota closed their churches to celebrate together. A true local fellowship."
